Monthly Debits take place on the 18th of each month up to and including November.

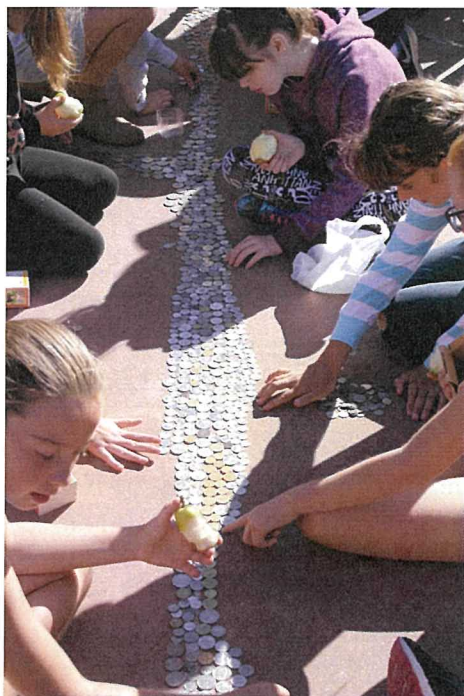
