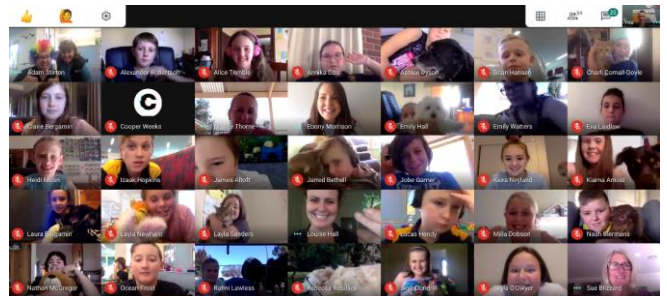
In my breaks, I get to play with our new adorable puppy Rusty.
