# **Triple A News - Uniform**


Welcome to Triple A News for 2021. Our Triple A Leaders for this year are Xavier Tonkin & Tahlia-Skye Kosanke.


Registrations will close on Thursday 20th February 2020 to allow time for teams and draws to be arranged.
