




If you are unable to attend on your day, can you please arrange a swap with someone else or as last resort let the Canteen Manager know in advance, so they are aware that they have no helper that day.

# VACATION CARE

Bookings are now open for Vacation Care, which shall be running again during the next school holidays Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursdays 8am to 4pm. cost shall remain the same, \$60.00 per day with Child Care subsidies also provided. Children will need to bring their own lunch, snacks and water bottle.

There will be a range of activities including craft, cooking, sport, indoor & outdoor games all onsite in the MacKillop Centre.

If your child is already enrolled in the Before & After School Care Program, then you can book via the My Family Lounge App just like Before and After School Care.

If you have not used the program before, then you will need to enrol your child/ren <u>via the school</u> website.

If you have never used the My Family Lounge, you will need to register and request a booking. Once your request has been accepted, (usually within 48 hours) you will need to complete an enrolment for each child. Please note that this will need to be completed on a desktop computer as not all functions work on a tablet or phone. Once completed, please click on the submit tab as this will send your information to our system. You will need to acknowledge that you are using our service via your MyGov account to receive any Child Care Subsidies. This may also include completing details regarding your employment and/or personal family situation. You will now be able to download the My Family Lounge App to manage your bookings.
