## COVID : PARENT/CARER VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

\* If you are visiting school you are no longer required to show your vacc passport. If you are volunteering, then you must check in at the office and show evidence of your two doses of covid vaccine.

So what does this mean ???

If you are volunteering in the canteen, hearing reading in the classroom or going on excursion with the kids then you must be double vaccinated.

If you are coming to an assembly, attending the Mother's Day Breaky or watching the X-Country then all are welcome.

\*Please continue to contact the school if your family has a positive case.

\*We ask that RATs continue to be done twice a week for the first four weeks.

\*Face masks are no longer a requirement

\*If you have contracted covid, you don't have to test for eight weeks from release from isolation.

\*Household contacts can now attend school but should wear a face mask and test daily for the week.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**My child has lost their information sheet, so I don't have their shootkey. What should I do?**

Your school administration has a list of all students' unique shootkeys. They will be able to issue the key to you again.

**My child never received an information sheet or shootkey.**

This is likely because your child was a late enrolment, or a new student. If you call MSP Photography on 03 5482 3190 we can issue you one immediately.

**Can I also order if my partner and I have separated?**

Of course. Simply use the same shootkey to order for your child. Any students with multiple orders processed will have their photographs sent to the front office of the school to ensure orders are delivered to the correct parent.

**How do I order a family photo?**

Each student has been issued with a corresponding unique shootkey for a family photo. Order using the shootkey on the oldest child's information sheet. Record your order reference number, and be sure to fill out the family details in the section provided on the oldest child's information sheet. There is no need to record it on all siblings' sheets.

**I didn't receive an order reference number, but the money has been taken out of my bank account.**

Your order will automatically be received by our system. Simply send your child on photo day with their information sheet as normal.

**I can't pay today. Will I still be able to get photos?**

Of course. All students will have their portrait taken regardless of whether you are purchasing photos or not. Online ordering will remain open for 3 calendar days after photo day. If you are still unable to order in this time frame, please contact us and we will endeavour to help you out.

## Course Delivery

- Blended delivery - alternating one day per fortnight; face to face in the classroom and one day per fortnight online, over a 42 week period, excluding school holidays (48 weeks in total)
- On average, students must contribute at least 15 to 25 hours of study per week
