#### NAPLAN

Today we sent home our National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy **NAPLAN** results. For families, these reports provide an outline of children's achievement levels in the curriculum areas of Reading, Writing, Grammar and Punctuation, Spelling and Numeracy. These results are a "snapshot" taken on the day and under test conditions so there are many variables.

As a school, the overall results provide us with valuable feedback in relation to our teaching and learning practice and where we can best work to be even better at what we do. For us, the NAPLAN affirms our work as well as providing us with another tool for curriculum and student evaluation.


## **Community Notices**
